Guide to Farmville

Farmville offers something for everyone. This town, divided between Prince Edward and Cumberland counties, hosts multiple festivals, concerts and other events each year, bringing in people from all over the region. It's also the home of Longwood University, a Division I school that hosts athletic events throughout the year, including college basketball games and tournaments broadcast on ESPN.

Farmville is unique in that High Bridge Trail State Park starts in the middle of downtown, giving residents and visitors alike access to trails and beautiful scenic views. Then there's the restaurants and shops around town, also perfect for someone looking to explore on a quiet Saturday. And we can't forget to mention some of the newer projects, such as the town's splashpad, the Longwood Center for the Visual Arts and other attractions.

Finally, Farmville is also a town with a significant amount of history. The site of one of the last major battles of the Civil War, it's not uncommon to be able to examine artifacts during the monthly meetings of the Historical Society. You can also walk back through time and learn about some of the early heroes of the Civil Rights era at the Moton Museum. The actions of Barbara Rose Johns and her fellow students at what was then Moton High helped drive one of the lawsuits that formed the backbone of the Brown vs. Board of Education Supreme Court case. A trip to the Moton Museum also offers the chance to learn about other Civil Rights heroes of the time and the change their actions created.

So take a look around town. See some of these sights, try some food and take in all that Farmville has to offer.

HISTORY

Prince Edward County was formed in 1754 from Amelia County and named for Edward Augustus, son of Frederick, Prince of Wales. For over 100 years, the county courthouse was located at Worsham.

Patrick Henry, five-time Governor of Virginia, lived in Prince Edward County from 1786 to 1794 and served as Prince Edward's representative in the Virginia General Assembly. It was during that time that he delivered his famous "Give me Liberty or Give

Me Death" speech.

Hampden-Sydney College, located 5 miles south of Farmville, has been in continuous operation since Jan. 1, 1776. Hampden-Sydney College is the 10th oldest institution of higher learning in the United States and the last to be founded under the British Crown.

Chartered in 1839, Farmville Female Seminary, presently Longwood University, was established in Farmville. Longwood was the first state teacher training college in Virginia.

The Civil War, during its final stages, impacted the community with both armies marching through Farmville. The last major battle of the Civil War in Virginia was April 6, 1865, at Sailor's Creek, located on the Prince Edward and Amelia County lines.

ABOUT THE MOTON MUSEUM

Before Selma, before Montgomery, there was Farmville, where young people made history. In Farmville, the former Robert Russa Moton High School is now a National Historic Landmark and known as the Robert Russa Moton Museum. This facility helps preserve and constructively interpret the history of Civil Rights in education, specifically as it relates to the leading role that local Prince Edward County citizens played in America's transition from segregation to integration.

On April 23, 1951, a group of Moton High School students led by 16-year-old Barbara Rose Johns walked out of school. This effort produced three-fourths of the plaintiffs in Brown v. Board of Education (1954), a landmark Supreme Court decision. From 1959 to 1964, Prince Edward County closed its public schools to avoid integration. The Supreme Court in Griffin v. Prince Edward (1964) ordered schools to reopen, declaring "the time for mere 'deliberate speed' had run out."

Now the museum includes exhibits and materials that detail the period of that transition from segregation to integration of public education. It is also the home for community events each year, from political debates to public hearings focused on the future of the town. Currently it is being considered for approval as a World Heritage site.

MEDICAL

Centra Southside Community Hospital, a progressive acute care facility, offers many services to meet the needs of the communities it serves. The hospital has an interesting beginning: it actually started as an experiment. In the mid-1920s the Commonwealth Fund of New York provided funds to determine if proper health care could be provided in a rural setting and because of persistence and community determina-

tion, the doors of Southside Community Hospital opened with 40 beds in November 1927. Through the years, the hospital has continued to grow and meet more challenging health care needs.

In January 2006, Southside Community Hospital affiliated with Centra



Health, a Lynchburg-based hospital system consisting of Lynchburg General and Virginia Baptist Hospitals. This affiliation enables Centra Southside Community Hospital (CSCH) to provide greater value to its service area with updated clinical services, capital improvements and access to advancements in clinical care. A new Birth Center was added in 2007. This new center includes labor, delivery, recovery, postpartum suites that enable women to stay in the same room throughout their birth experience. Many board-certified physicians have been added to the staff, ranging from hospitalists to gastroenterologists. CSCH also has an ADA accredited Diabetic Education program, Hospice, Home Health and PACE (Program for the All Inclusive Care of the Elderly).

CSCH in Farmville is a 116-bed, full service acute care hospital which provides 24 hour emergency department, an intensive care unit, Same Day Surgery Center,

obstetrical/gynecological services, pediatrics, physical/speech/occupational therapy, radiology, pathology, birthing center, hospice and much more.

EDUCATIONAL FACILITIES

The influence of education is a dominant factor in the lives of everyone in the Farmville community. From preschool to college, opportunities exist for residents to achieve the highest degree of academic accomplishment.

PRINCE EDWARD COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM

Prince Edward County Public Schools provides a comprehensive education for all students in Prekindergarten – Grade 12, which includes core academic subjects, fine arts, extracurricular activities, career and technical education, and a strong athletic program. Students have the opportunity to take Dual Enrollment courses with South-

side Virginia Community College, and may complete an Associate Degree while completing the high school diploma. Advanced Placement courses are also available. Prince Edward County High School students participate in The Governor's School of Southside Virginia.



The Prince Edward

County Public Schools complex, including the Elementary, Middle and High Schools, as well as the Career and Technical Education Center, is located just south of the Town of Farmville on Zion Hill Road.

Currently the elementary portion of the complex is going through major renovations, completely redesigning everything from classrooms to the auditorium. The project just got started and is expected to be finished by 2027.

FUQUA SCHOOL

Fuqua School, a PK-12, college preparatory, independent day school, serves as a



model of educational excellence for rural America. Endowed by the late J.B. Fuqua, a nationally known businessman and philanthropist. A strong curriculum, high expectations for academic achievement and behavior and a nurturing learning environment foster the development of individual potential and character. Ninety-eight percent of Fuqua School's graduates

go on to college.

Much like Prince Edward Elementary, Fuqua School is going through its own renovation project. The facility is split into an Upper and Lower School, based on grade levels. Lower School is essentially elementary and middle school, while Upper School is the operation's high school grades. There will soon be a new, modernized Upper School on campus, a project launched in August 2024.

LONGWOOD UNIVERSITY

The legacy that began in 1839 continues today as Longwood University offers more

than 100 majors, minors and concentrations through its various academic programs. Given its historical roots, Longwood University enjoys an enviable reputation for teacher preparation. The excellence has expanded throughout the university with strong programs in the liberal arts and sciences, business, professional and pre-professional programs.



The university has

also developed a reputation for athletics, with both the men's and women's basketball teams making it to the NCAA Tournament twice over the last three years.

The school also recently opened a new $4{,}000$ seat arena, called the Joan Perry Brock Center, on campus. That is the home for both men's and women's basketball at the university, along with concerts, comedians and other programs for the community.

HAMPDEN-SYDNEY COLLEGE

For more than two centuries, Hampden-Sydney College has been dedicated to the formation of "good men and good citizens."

Hampden-Sydney College students pursue a traditional liberal arts curriculum.



Students participate in the College's nationally recognized Rhetoric Program, which stresses writing across the curriculum and requires proficiency in the written and oral expression of the English language. The College is committed to the belief that a liberal arts edu-

cation provides the best foundation, not only for a career, but also for the great moral and intellectual challenges of life.

The school is also known for holding regional and state political discussions. Much like Longwood in Farmville, Hampden-Sydney College has developed a reputation for first-class athletics on the NCAA Division III level. The school's basketball team made it to the NCAA Tournament two of the last three years, with the Tigers advancing to the D3 National Championship game in 2024. The football team is also growing and developing, adding new facilities, bringing on extra staff and recently hiring Vince Luvara to take over the program after the retirement of Hall of Fame Head Coach Marty Favret.

SOUTHSIDE VIRGINIA COMMUNITY COLLEGE

Southside Virginia Community College, is a part of the Virginia Community College System with campus locations in Keysville (20 miles south of Farmville) and Alberta as well as numerous off-campus sites. Established in 1970, the college offers a university parallel college transfer program and associate degree programs including engineering, technology, health and public service technology, business and information systems technology. The college offers a competitive tuition and provides financial aid assistance to many qualifying students.

YMCA

The Southside Virginia Family YMCA is a full service family fitness and recreation provider. Programs range from arts and humanities to aquatics and fitness for all ages, infants to seniors. The facility located on 580 Commerce Road has a recreation pool, large fitness center, group exercise room, teen center and children's activity gym. Also on the 32 acre site, there is an outdoor walking trail, outdoor adult fitness area, horseshoe pits and two multipurpose athletic fields.

RECREATION

Recreational activities of a remarkably wide selection are available in Prince Edward County and surrounding Southside Virginia. Every season offers a selection of enjoyable choices for individuals of all age groups.

The Farmville Recreation Department offers a wide variety of recreational programs, to include: adult volleyball; adult basketball; men's, women's and coed softball; youth football and numerous seasonal arts and crafts programs for adults and

youth. Summer programs are offered cooperatively with numerous agencies within the county. Call (434) 392-3737 for more information about these programs. The town



also operates a splashpad, which is open from Memorial Day to Labor Day each year. It is approximately 5,000 square feet and can be found on West Third Street, at the entrance to the Wilck's Lake Island area. In the future, basketball and pickleball courts will be built at the complex, in addition to trails connecting with High Bridge Trail State Park, which you can read about below.

BEAR CREEK LAKE STATE PARK


Nestled in the heart of the Cumberland State Forest in central Virginia, is just 26 minutes from Farmville. It's the perfect getaway for the outdoor enthusiast. Activities center on the 40-acre lake with a boat launch, fishing pier, boat rentals and a swimming beach. Other attractions include a meeting facility, cabins, camping, picnicking, an archery range and playgrounds.

HIGH BRIDGE TRAIL STATE PARK

High Bridge Trail is 31.2 miles long and ideally suited for hiking, bicycling and horse-

back riding. The trail that was once a railway and the location of one of the last battles of the American Civil War is wide, level and generally flat. Its finely crushed limestone surface and dimensions make it easy to enjoy.

The park's centerpiece is the majestic High Bridge, which is more than 2,400 feet long and 125 feet towering above the Appomattox River. It is the longest recreational bridge in Virginia and among the longest in the United States. High Bridge, a Virginia Historic Landmark, is on the National Register of Historic Places. The trail is a National Recreation Trail recognizing exemplary trails of local and regional significance, connecting people to nature, to



each other, and to our shared history and culture. Bring drinking water because none is available on the trail.

HOLLIDAY LAKE STATE PARK

Deep in the Appomattox-Buckingham State Forest, Holliday Lake is a paradise for the outdoor enthusiast. Fishing for largemouth bass, crappie and bluegill is popular. Swimming at the park's guarded beach and the "Critter Hole" play area are visitor favorites. The park has several hiking trails, including a connector trail to the 10.2-mile Carter Taylor Multi-use Trail for hikers, bicyclists and horseback riders. Visitors enjoy its campgrounds, picnic shelters, playgrounds, seasonal concession stand, gift shop and boat ramp.

SAILOR'S CREEK BATTLEFIELD HISTORICAL STATE PARK

On April 6, 1865, nearly a quarter of Confederate Gen. Robert E. Lee's army, more than 7,700 men, were killed, wounded or captured here. Lee surrendered 72 hours later at Appomattox Court House. Historical interpreters present various programs and living history events take place at various times throughout the year. Motorists traveling along Lee's Retreat may learn more about the battle through signs at each stop.





TWIN LAKES STATE PARK

In the heart of central Virginia, this historic park offers many cultural, environmental and recreational activities. Overnight accommodations include a 33-site campground and 11 climate-controlled cabins. Visitors enjoy swimming, seasonal snack bar,

fishing, hiking, boating and lakeside picnicking. The Cedar Crest Conference Center on Prince Edward Lake is available for weddings, family gatherings, retreats and business meetings.

CULTURAL ACTIVITIES

There are a number of festivals, concerts and community events that take place in Farmville and Prince Edward County throughout the year.

Longwood University sponsors a variety of programs each year in the performing arts including The Christmas Dinner and Concert and the Chamber Music Series, which are very special events and unique to the area.

Throughout the academic year, the Longwood Players present a series of plays, and performances by the Concert Choir, the Camerata Singers, the Jazz Band and The Longwood University Company of Dancers are presented for the pleasure of the student body and the members of the community.

The Longwood Center for the Visual Arts offers a wide variety of quality exhibitions accompanied by educational programs such as lectures, gallery talks, workshops, seminars and docent-led tours. The permanent Collection features 19th century American paintings, work by 20th century Virginia artists, contemporary crafts, and a study collection of paintings and decorative arts.



For over 25 years, the Waterworks Players have brought the magic of live theatre to area audiences and provided an artistic outlet for local actors, singers, designers and technicians.

Their performance season, which starts in October and runs through the spring of each year, features a variety of different shows, including a traditional European Christmas panto performance, musicals and comedies.

The Heart of Virginia Festival is an annual celebration, held in Farmville, each September. It is the site of one of the largest arts and crafts shows in Southside Virginia. Paintings and educational exhibits are displayed on the lawn of Longwood University, just one block from the downtown area, where the arts and crafts are presented.

A rubber duck race gets things started on Friday, followed by a 10k race on Saturday morning and an outdoor concert wind up the events Saturday evening. The festival was first held in 1978 and has become one of the most popular attractions in the area, with crowds estimated at more than 25,000 over the two-day event.


